Early Years Pupil Premium was introduced to enhance and support children in order to improve their outcomes.

The children that are eligible receive an extra 53p per funded hour up to the 15 hour entitlement. The EYPP has to be applied for each term by the parent/carer. The Nursery School receives the funding.
