At present; staff, parents or child that have been in close contact with confirmed case will be notified by NHS Test and Trace and informed to take a PCR test. Children and staff will continue to attend School unless a Positive PCR or told to isolate by NHS Test and Trace. Self-isolation guidance updated from NHS will be followed.	NF	Ongoing from Sept 21
