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Transmission of Covid 19	All persons on school site	Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19. Take advice as directed by guidance from the DFE / PHE and NNC .	<p>SBM to read information sent out, distributing as appropriate and required.</p> <p>At present; staff, parents or child that have been in close contact with confirmed case will be notified by NHS Test and Trace and informed to do daily lateral flow tests.</p> <p>Children and staff will continue to attend School unless a Positive PCR or told to isolate by NHS Test and Trace.</p> <p>Self-isolation guidance updated from NHS will be followed.</p>	SBM	Ongoing from Sept 21	
Transmission of Covid	All	All control measures in place- including face masks in communal areas.	Parents and staff informed that all individuals who have been identified as a close contact of a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 are to take a PCR test. Should an individual have been in contact with someone who has tested positive, they are required to take daily lateral flow tests for 7 days. Only those who test positive will then be required to take a PCR test and isolate for 7 days if positive.	SBM	From Dec 21- temp measure	

			People who cannot be vaccinated for clinical reasons are allowed to do daily testing, along with children aged 5 to 18-years-old. Under 5s are exempt from daily testing.			
Transmission of Covid	All	All staff, visitors and parents are strongly advised to wear face masks when moving around communal areas, this includes key transition times of drop off and collection of children. Also includes any meetings or whether staff may gather in communal areas.
